Jorge is a portfolio manager. He joined the North Growth portfolio management team in April 2020.

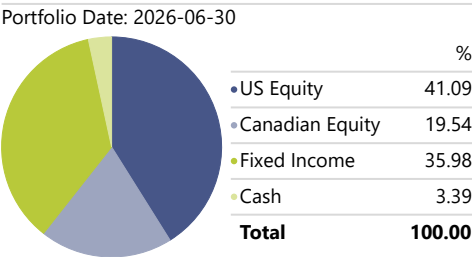
